## **✓ Fiscal Responsibility & Accountability**

- Stopped collecting water tap fees for a Water Fund for a dam that had been vetoed years before
- Used \$6 million *cash* from “the defunct Water Fund” to solve the space needs of the Police Department (\$18 million less than the financed building voters rejected in November 2004)
- Saved citizens \$3.5 million on proposed sewer plant disinfection that had already scheduled
- Cut \$2 million from 2011 City general fund budget without sacrificing safety, health & welfare of the citizens
- Instructed City Manager to bring a 2012 budget with expenditures equaling revenues
- Work with other jurisdictions formally & informally to cut costs & improve efficiency & effectiveness

## **✓ Transparency & Open Government**

- Channel 8: restored programming, & broadcast & rebroadcast *all* meetings of City Council, the Planning Commission & the Licensing Authority
- Broadcasts of meetings are now video-streamed on the City website & are available for at least 5 years.
- Annual Council Workshops (formerly “Retreats”) are now held in Littleton so that citizens can attend.
- I will continue to advocate that the annual Council Workshop be held where it can be broadcast on Channel 8 & video-streamed on the City website so that citizens who cannot attend can watch it live or later.
- I will continue to work to ensure full disclosure of agenda items in a timely way, giving citizens adequate time to consider issues & express their views before decisions are made.

## **✓ Economic & Social Vitality**

- Continue to support Littleton’s nationally acclaimed Economic Gardening program, which has helped Littleton thrive & weather several recessions

## **✓ Preserving the Quality of our Neighborhoods & the Quality of our Lives**

- Partnered with South Suburban Parks & Recreation, Arapahoe County & Great Outdoors Colorado to leverage \$1.7 million of City open space money into a \$7.9 million investment in Littleton

**October 3: last day to register**

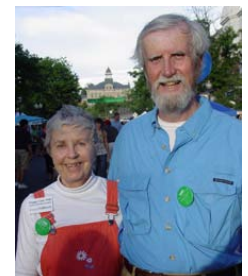
**October 11 - 21: ballots mailed**

**November 1: ballots due**

**City Council has 7 members.**

They elect the Mayor & Mayor Pro Tem from among their members.

- Littleton has 4 Districts. Each district elects 1 member to serve a 4-year term.
  - Voters in District 2 & District 4 will elect their representatives in this election.
- 3 Council Members at Large are elected by all the voters; 2 are elected every 2 years.
  - The at-large candidate who receives the most votes serves a 4-year term.
  - The at-large candidate who finishes second serves a 2-year term.
